

## STUDENT ACTIVITIES

Code **JJ** Issued **9/04**

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Purpose: To establish the board's vision regarding student activities and the basic structure for the conduct of those activities.

The board regards student activities at the center as a vital part of the total educational program as long as the center safeguards the development and well-being of the students. The center should use these activities as a means of developing wholesome attitudes and good human relations as well as knowledge and skills.

The board sanctions student activities that traditionally have been a part of the overall center program provided center personnel properly supervise and operate the activities in accordance with center policies and regulations.

The board considers student activities to be part of the total center curriculum. Club sponsors must develop, manage and evaluate these activities with this purpose in mind. Center personnel should be included in regular curriculum planning, review and evaluation processes regarding these activities.

Center personnel, the club sponsor and the director will be responsible for the organization of all student activities. Center personnel will provide adequate supervision, administer student finances and manage all student activities with the approval of the director.
