EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

Purpose: To establish the board's vision regarding the evaluation of the center's instructional programs.

Effective classroom instruction rests on continuous evaluation of the instructional program.

The center will design its evaluation program to compare student progress with the aims and objectives established by the center's strategic plan. The administration may consider a variety of evaluation instruments and techniques when selecting the means of evaluating different programs and activities. The methods will utilize state and district mandated tests to generate a performance index for the center.

The director may submit an annual report to the board stating the strengths and weaknesses of the center program. Plans for correcting the weaknesses may be a part of the report.

When evaluation data pertaining to individual students and teachers are used for decision making or any other professional purpose, the center will treat the data with the utmost confidentiality. The center will preserve the anonymity of individual students and teachers when system-wide data are made public.
